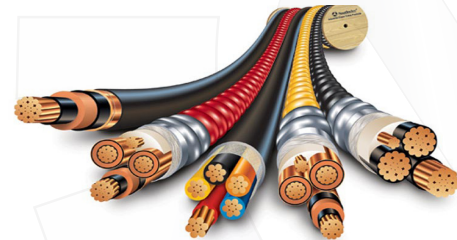
Chamber Services

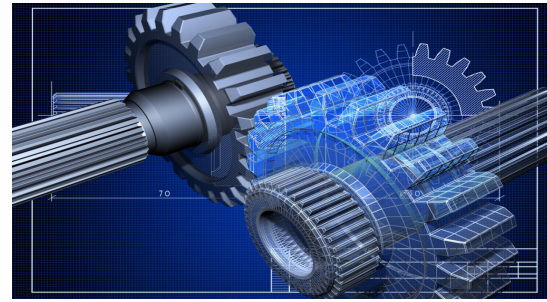
